You'll leave with finished jewelry and possess the skills which are the foundation of your future creative explorations with metal clay! Additional \$60 materials fee, includes 20g silver clay and the use of all tools.

Create hollow beads without a burnable form! You'll use dies to emboss designs into the clay then learn how to dome the clay and use dry assembly techniques to put them all together. You will make several beads in this class. Materials list.

Have you ever seen the rain falling and then running in rivulets down the window? It can be quite mesmerizing and beautiful. In this class you will learn how to form the earrings or pendant to a perfect 90° fold then set a bezel for a CZ onto the piece with this complex angle, then decorate it with the syringe to look like rivulets of water. Materials list.

Bling It On \$69

What woman doesn't like a little bling in her dress. Why not accentuate it with a little bling in a ring. Learn how to make bezels for CZs and shape them to set in a ring, create a ring band with texture and integrate all this into a unique one of a kind creation. Sizing this ring is quite different than your standard band and may require re-sizing after firing. Materials list.

*Workshop Levels:

Level 1

All skill levels welcome, from absolute beginners to those wishing to refine skills or refresh techniques. In class firing and polishing/finishing. Relaxed pace.

Level 2

Must have taken Metal Clay Foundation Skills. Building on established skills, basic stone setting, syringe work, using a needle tool, dry assembly. Moderate pace. Requires at home polishing/finishing.

Level 3

Must have taken any Level 2 class. Skills will be refined, and understanding expanded, multi-tasking. Brisk pace. Requires at home polishing/finishing.

Level 4

Must have taken several Level 3 classes. More challenging and independent working environment. Improvisation and design opportunities. Brisk pace, may not be finished during class. Requires at home polishing/finishing.

You will also learn how to create different looks with the same mold. Materials list.

Swing of the Pendulum \$75

Sometimes life takes a major swing, just like a pendulum. Transform that concept into wearable art. In this class you will learn advanced control of syringe, working with a 3 dimensional piece and flush setting CZs. You will also learn how to make a swivel so your piece will swing like a pendulum. Materials list.

Peek-a-Boo Owl Focal Toggle \$69

Learn the parts of a toggle clasp and how they work as you create a dwelling for this little owl to survey his world from. You will learn how to stack layers to create a fitted shelf for the owl to rest in so that the two parts of the toggle fit and stay together, and how to create the bails so that the pieces stay in place. With the skills gained in this class, you will have the knowledge to create your own unique clasps. Materials list.

Moyogi Tree \$69

In the bonsai world, Moyogi refers to a bonsai tree whose trunk draws curves in patterns. Create shadow box for this graceful tree, replete with sparkling accents reminiscent of Japanese cherry blossoms. Skills learned will include creating a textured frame, building a supporting wall, and flush setting CZs. And no green thumb required! Dry construction experience helpful. Materials list.

Hollow Box Pendant \$75

This enchanting little pendant is a hollow 3-D form that is decorated with embossed paper-type clay and decorative clay "rivets". Snake rolling, clay embossing, texture masking, embedding wire and dry assembly round out the techniques covered in this project. You can decorate each side differently to make a reversible pendant. Dangles of chain and beads add just the right amount of color and movement. Materials list.

Convertible Chain \$75

Unlock the mysteries of making chain links out of metal clay as well as how to create a nearly invisible toggle. Double-sided texturing adds to the design possibilities. We'll focus on the bracelet in class, then on your own you can create the necklace. Connect them together to wear a longer necklace or wear the bracelet and necklace separately. Materials list.

Vines growing up and through the glass actually hold these two diverse materials together. This class showcases another great way to combine glass and silver clay. Firing the two together always adds to the intrigue, the ins-and-outs of this union will be covered. Other techniques practiced will be making snakes and carving with a scalpel. Make yours as simple or ornate as you like! Materials list.

Falling Leaf Keum-boo \$75

Accent your metal clay pieces with gold using the ancient Korean art of Keum-Boo. You will make a textured pendant, roll & texture branches, apply silver paper leaves then learn how to embellish it with 24K gold foil. A rainbow patina adds the finishing touch. Keum-boo is a versatile and affordable technique you will use over and over again! Materials list.

The Tangled Web We Weave \$75

2 Parts: Wed. & Th. Oct 7 & 8 (6-9p) or
Sat. Oct. 24 (10a-5p)

Conquer your fear of spiders with this cute mama and her baby around your neck. Learn to follow a pattern with syringe to create a design and set a delightful spider made from metal clay and CZ in the middle. Dangle her little baby from a wire to complete the picture. Materials list.

Bubbling Beauty \$75

This piece is reminiscent of days spent on the beach searching for colorful beach glass. You will create bezel settings for your CZs and arrange them in a pleasing way that makes them look like they are washing ashore. You will create a wave that washes over them, partially covering them and providing additional support. Random granulation will complete the picture, making them look like they are surrounded by sea foam. Materials list.

Winter Wonderland \$75

You can almost feel the serenity as this majestic pine, decorated in snow and softly lit by a full moon, is quietly protected by a watchful, yet welcoming, feline beckoning you to take a closer look. You will learn how to assemble components, carve a dimensional character, create a hidden bail, and complete your scene with silver flake snow. Materials list.
